MEADOW ISD WELLNESS POLICY REVIEW

The Meadow ISD Wellness Policy – FFA (Local) was reviewed on November 17, 2015. The review determined that the policy, which was officially adopted by the board of trustees on March 6, 2006, continues to conform to the practices of the Meadow Independent School District. The following revisions were recommended to meet the new guidelines from the Texas Department of Agriculture:

Under Nutrition guidelines (policy FFA – Local)

Change Texas Public School Nutrition Policy to Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act and Smart Snacks in Schools.

District designated exempt fundraiser days shall be recorded each year in the Superintendent's Office by Darrian Dover, Superintendent and should not exceed six days per campus per year.

All other fundraising activities that take place during the school day must follow Smart Snacks Guidelines.

Under Wellness Goals Nutrition Education (policy FFA – Local)

A coordinated health program with a nutrition education component will be taught in the elementary/ secondary PE classes.

Under physical activity (policy FFA – Local)

Recess period will be available to students daily in grades PK-5.

Under implementation (policy FFA – Local)

The Child Nutrition Director, Ann Callaway, shall oversee the implementation of this policy and shall develop administrative procedures for annually measuring the implementation of the wellness policy.

Parents, community members and students will be involved in the development and periodic evaluation of this policy through eight (8) representatives on the committee.
