At Meadow ISD your child's welfare is our utmost concern. Recognizing the recent outbreak in flu cases state wide we have taken the following precautions:

1. Meadow ISD for the last two years is a client of Germ-Blast. Germ-Blast is a comprehensive environmental disinfection program proven to reduce illness and infection. (I would encourage you to look at their website at www.germblast.com)
2. We have hand sanitizers placed in hallways
3. Faculty and staff frequently remind students of safe practices
4. Our custodial personnel work extremely hard to prevent problem areas

Even with the above strategies in place 100% prevention isn't possible but we feel these strategies have helped prevent major illness breakout in our district up to this point. Our attendance over the past 5 – 7 days has been down approximately 7% from usual. We are asking for parents to help with situation by using the following strategies:

1. If your child wakes up with a fever over 100 please keep at home until he/she is fever free without medicine for 24 hours. This also includes after school events
2. If your child complains of flu like symptoms we will side with caution and ask for you to pick your child up to go home.

The school districts across the state that are shutting the doors for a few days are doing so to have their buildings cleaned to the level that we already are. I'm not anticipating Meadow ISD having to shut the doors because of the precautions we already have in place. With your cooperation we will get through this.
